On a city tour we will visit the Citadel Hill with its early 19th century star-shaped fort and Fairview Cemetery, the final resting for more than 100 people who perished on the ill-fated voyage of the Titanic and other sites.

Visit Prince Edward Island and Anne of Green Gables country to experience lush countryside and red-sanded beaches. In New Brunswick, drive along the rugged coastline and see rock formations carved by the world's highest tides in the Bay of Fundy.

Continue on to Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont where we will experience the quaint New England charm. We spend a final evening in Finger Lakes region before traveling back to Michigan.

SEPT 8 DAY 1

SEPT 13 DAY 6

This morning we leave Nova Scotia for Prince Edward Island. This afternoon enter the magical and enchanting world of Anne of Green Gables. Visit the **Anne of Green Gables house** in Cavendish. Stroll through Lover's Lane and other settings from the literary classic. Continue to North Rustico to see its iconic lighthouses and amazing views. Tonight enjoy a lobster supper. **CB, D Summerside PEI**

SEPT 14 DAY 7

Travel across the 8 Mile Confederation Bridge to New Brunswick. Here we will observe the gradual rise and fall of the Bay of Fundy tides. The Fundy Tides are the highest on earth and rise and fall an astounding 50 feet. **CB,D St John NB.**

SEPT 15 DAY 8

Our Canadian journey comes to an end as we cross the border back into the United States and make our way to Brunswick Maine where we spend the night. **CB, D Brunswick ME**

SEPT 16 DAY 9

Continue on to Rutland VT with stops at **King Arthur's Baking School** and **F H Gillingham's, a Vermont Country Stor**e in the picturesque village of Woodstock VT. **CB, D Rutland VT**
